

Schedule of Dues and Fees (Effective August 1, 2026)

Gamma Phi Beta Bylaws require International Council to set all fees for the upcoming fiscal year by March 1 annually and distribute a complete schedule of fees. International Council has approved the following fee structure for the upcoming fiscal year (August 1, 2026, to July 31, 2027).

Collegiate Member Dues and Fees		
Due/Fee	Amount	Frequency and Billing Format
Membership Fee	\$175	One-time fee, paid by new members.
International Facility Fee	\$30	One-time fee, paid by new members.
International Dues	\$142	Billed semiannually on October 1 and February 1 in two equal installments, paid by initiated members.
Liability Insurance Premium	\$45	Billed annually on February 1, paid by new and initiated members.
National Panhellenic Conference Fee	\$5	Billed annually on February 1, paid by new and initiated members.

- Member education such as Fidelity for New Members and Fidelity for Initiated Members.

- Liability insurance for members, officers and volunteers.
- Educational resources for chapter officers on GammaPhiBeta.org.
- Officer training through Fidelity for Officers and Executive Council Officer Retreats.
- OmegaRecruit subscription, which supports chapters in delivering successful and efficient recruitment efforts as well as compliance with Gamma Phi Beta’s required membership selection procedures.
- OmegaOne subscription, which supports chapters in delivering efficient chapter operations and provides an emergency response check for collegiate chapters.
- Access to Beta Base for required chapter reporting, convenient event registration and easy roster management.
- Collegiate leadership consultant (CLC) program, which allows recently graduated alumnae to travel to Gamma Phi Beta collegiate chapters to provide leadership and training, guide chapters in self-assessment and facilitate workshops.
- International volunteer and professional staff visits, which provide chapters with support in chapter operations and advisor development.
- Production and annual subscription for all collegiate members to our award-winning lifestyle magazine, *The Crescent*.
- A well-equipped volunteer and staff workforce that provides support and guidance for collegiate chapters.

\$40	Billed annually on August 1, paid by alumnae members (Life Loyal alumnae members are excluded).
\$375	Life Loyal fees are elective and can be paid by any alumna who wish to fulfill her lifetime alumnae dues obligations in a single one-time payment.
\$250	Life Loyal fees are elective and can be paid by any alumna who wish to fulfill her lifetime alumnae dues obligations in a single one-time payment.
