



UPDATING CHAPTER BUDGETS FOR FALL 2020

Given the rapidly changing landscape of higher education in response to COVID-19 across North America, we believe that collegiate chapters can confidently make the following budget modifications for fall 2020. RECOMMENDATION BUDGET MODIFICATIONS FOR FALL 2020

Chapter Meetings

Per the guidance provided in Fall 2020 Chapter Operations and In-Person Event Expectations, chapters should evaluate their meeting space rental budget to reduce/eliminate expenses, unless your chapter qualifies for an exception.

International Representative Visits

Collegiate leadership consultants (CLCs) were not hired for the 2020-21 academic year. As a result, any money chapters have budgeted for CLC visits can be eliminated.

Volunteer travel is not authorized during the fall 2020 academic term. As a result, any money chapters have budgeted for collegiate chapter supervisor visits during the fall 2020 academic term can be eliminated.

Moonball

Per the guidance provided in Fall 2020 Chapter Operations and In-Person Event Expectations, chapters should evaluate their philanthropy budget to reduce/eliminate expenses, unless your chapter qualifies for an exception.

Recruitment

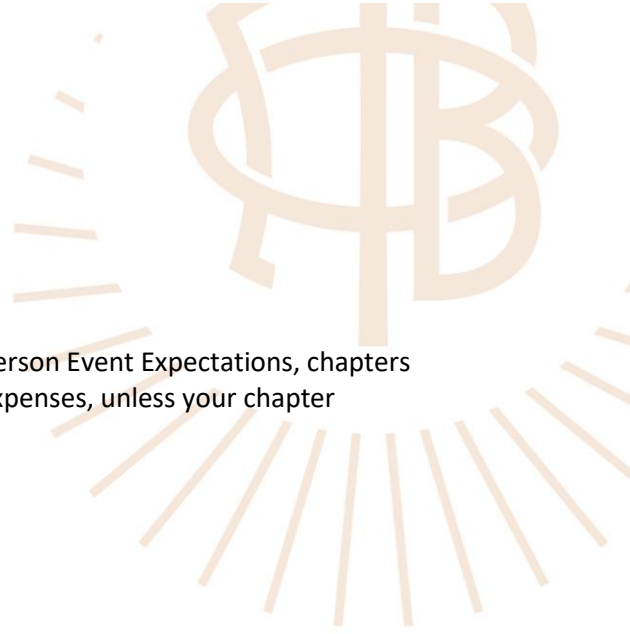
