Nominating Committee Timeline

- **October 25, 2025:** Application preview live on website
- **November 3, 2025:** Application opens/Names of reapplying IC members posted to website/Comment Form live
- **January 7, 2026:** Application closes
- **January 12, 2026:** All applicant names posted to website
- **January 28-February 28, 2026:** Interviews
- **February 28, 2026:** Comment Form closes/All applicant names removed from website
- **March 12-16, 2026:** NC Slating Retreat
- **March 17, 2026:** List of slated candidates posted on the website and sent to the membership
- **By April 1, 2026:** Complete NC report posted on the website and sent to the membership
- **April 15, 2026:** Deadline to notify NC Chair of intent to run from the floor for election at Convention
- **July 15-19, 2026:** Convention in Louisville/Formal elections and officer installations
