

## 2025 Dinner With 12 Sisters- Host FAQ

### 1. What is Dinner With 12 Sisters?

Dinner With 12 Sisters (DW12S) is one way Gamma Phi Beta alumnae members can engage with the Sorority and individual sisters. From **Thursday, February 20 to Sunday, February 23**, hosts in over 30 cities nationwide will gather with other sisters to enjoy good food and better conversation while connecting over their common bond of Gamma Phi Beta.

### 2. What exactly am I signing up for?

As a host, you commit to a day and time from Thursday, February 20 to Sunday, February 23 to host a meal for 12 people (yourself included). **Depending on your space and desires, you can host your event at your home or a restaurant.** Hosts are expected to coordinate all aspects of the evening, including reserving a table at a restaurant, cooking or catering, and answering host-specific questions from attendees.

### 3. Does International Headquarters provide support to hosts?

Gamma Phi Beta will help to market the event to alumnae in the area, process registration, collect fees and communicate who has reserved a spot at your table!

### 4. Are there costs associated with hosting an event?

Attendees are required to pay a registration fee. The default registration fee for all events is \$40 per person. Hosts can request an alternative registration fee (higher or lower) based on event needs. When planning, hosts should identify options that, including any tax, extra gratuity or tip, would be within their pre-determined event cost. **Hosts should be prepared to pay for the meal up front.** These funds will be given back to the host through reimbursement for the direct costs of the meal.

### 5. How do members register?

In early January, [GammaPhiBeta.org](https://GammaPhiBeta.org) will launch online registration. Also, in January, those who live geographically close to the host will receive email communication about these events. Since this program aims to reconnect our “less engaged” members to the Sorority, please wait to share the link with those you know so that you don’t end up at a table with only your friends.

### 6. Will I know who is attending my event beforehand?

Yes! Once you commit to being a host, you will receive access to the registration report, including registered member information after successful payment.

### 7. What are the next steps?

If you haven’t already done so, complete a **host interest form** to provide us with your information. Selected areas and hosts will be contacted in November to begin the event planning process.
