

Alumnae Chapter Awards

Alumnae/Collegiate Relations Award

This award recognizes an alumnae and collegiate chapter that through a successful joint effort have strong communications, rapport, understanding and cooperation toward a shared purpose or goal that may include, but not limited to, an event, activity, program, scholarship or senior event.

Criteria

The criteria for selection of this award include all of the following:

- Collegiate and alumnae chapter were in good standing in 2024 and 2025.
- Collegiate and alumnae chapter demonstrate outstanding communications, rapport, understanding and cooperation between a collegiate chapter and an alumnae chapter for the achievement of a shared purpose or goal such as a shared event/program, scholastic achievement, philanthropic efforts, recruitment efforts and others.
- Certification from collegiate chapter supervisor and alumnae chapter supervisor that chapters are eligible for the award.

Award submission:

- Alumnae and collegiate chapter names
- Chapter statement (not to exceed 1,000 words) describing:
 - The shared purpose or goal of alumnae engagement efforts
 - The outcome of shared purpose or goal
 - The ways the shared purpose or goal strengthened the relationship between the collegiate and alumnae chapter.

Supplemental material:

- Applicants may submit no more than three pages of supplemental material (i.e. copy of event programs, social media screenshots, photographs from events, newsletters, etc.).
- Supplemental materials must be submitted as a PDF. No hard copy supplemental materials are accepted.

Beatrice Locke Hogan Award

This award recognizes an alumna member that serves in an alumnae chapter or local community in addition to serving in a Panhellenic community through various roles. The efforts of this alumna member can include general involvement to a leadership role all the while promoting the Panhellenic ideals.

Criteria

The criteria for selection of this award include all of the following:

- Alumna member was in good standing in 2024 and 2025.
- Alumna member serves the alumnae chapter and/or local community in addition to serving in a Panhellenic community (i.e., general involvement or a leadership role).
- Alumna member exemplifies and promotes Panhellenic ideals within the alumnae Panhellenic and local community through general involvement or a specific leadership role.
- Letter of recommendation from alumnae chapter, alumnae Panhellenic member or local community member the demonstrates why alumna member is deserving of this award.
- Certification from alumnae chapter supervisor that alumnae member is eligible for the award.

Award submission:

- Name and contact information of person submitting award nomination
- Name of alumna being nominated
- Role(s) the alumna member holds in alumnae chapter and/or local community
- Role(s) the alumna member holds in alumnae Panhellenic
- Chapter statement (not to exceed 500 words) describing:
- How the member exemplifies and promotes Panhellenic ideals within the alumnae Panhellenic and local community.

Supplemental material:

- Applicants may submit no more than three pages of supplemental material (i.e. copies of locally received awards and recognitions, photos of member involvement in alumnae chapter, local community, or Panhellenic community).
- Supplemental materials must be submitted as a PDF. No hard copy supplemental materials are accepted.

Chicago Award

This award recognizes chapters that promote the values of Gamma Phi Beta through consistent demonstrations of sisterhood, loyalty and support of sisters through various events, programs, activities and individual caring of members.

Criteria

The criteria for selection of this award include all of the following:

- Alumnae chapter was in good standing in 2024 and 2025.
- Alumnae chapter displays consistent and sustained demonstrations of sisterhood, loyalty and support of sisters through various events, programs, activities and individual caring of members.
- Certification from alumnae chapter supervisor that alumnae chapter is eligible for the award.

Award submission:

- Chapter name
- Chapter statement (not to exceed 1,000 words) describing:
 - How your chapter promotes the values of Gamma Phi Beta through consistent demonstrations of sisterhood, loyalty and support of sisters through various events, programs, activities and individual caring of members

Supplemental material:

- Applicants may submit no more than three pages of supplemental material (i.e. photos from events, programs or activities, copies of communication to members, event invitations, etc.).
- Supplemental materials must be submitted as a PDF. No hard copy supplemental materials are accepted.

Clara Worden Membership Excellence Award

This award recognizes alumnae chapters that have shown continuous growth of membership over a four-year period that have directly been shown to benefit various chapter events, its members and general alumnae chapter life.

Criteria

The criteria for selection of this award include all of the following:

- Alumnae chapter was in good standing in 2024 and 2025.
- Alumnae chapter can demonstrate year-over-year membership growth over a four-year period (2022-2025).
- Alumnae chapter can demonstrate improvements in all areas of chapter life (i.e., communications/public relations; collegiate chapter support; member involvement (dues paying members, member retention, member recognition); philanthropy and service; chapter operations.
- Certification from alumnae chapter supervisor that alumnae chapter is eligible for the award.

Award submission:

- Chapter name
- Chapter statement (not to exceed 1,000 words) describing:
 - How the alumnae chapter has grown and
 - The ways that the chapter has shown improvements in:
 - Communications/public relations
 - Collegiate chapter support
 - Member involvement (dues paying members, member retention and recognition)
 - Philanthropy and service
 - Chapter operations

Supplemental material:

- Applicants may submit no more than three pages of supplemental material (i.e. photos from events, programs, activities, philanthropic efforts; communication sent to members; outreach to potential new members; recruitment plans, etc.)
- Supplemental materials must be submitted as a PDF. No hard copy supplemental materials are accepted.

Philanthropic Excellence Award

This award recognizes chapters that have shown continuous direct support of Gamma Phi Beta's partner Girls on the Run and the promotion of the philanthropic idea of Building Strong Girls.

Criteria

The criteria for selection of this award include all of the following:

- Alumnae chapter was in good standing in 2024 and 2025.
- Alumnae chapter has supported Girls on the Run and/or a girl-focused philanthropic organization through volunteer service during the biennium.
- Alumnae chapter has properly submitted funds to our philanthropic partner and/or a girl-focused philanthropic organization by submitting funds to the Gamma Phi Beta Foundation and properly completing the Philanthropy Donation Form in Beta Base each year of the biennium.
- Certification from alumnae chapter supervisor that alumnae chapter is eligible for the award.

Award submission:

- Chapter name
- Funds donated and organizations supported
- List all alumnae chapters who have supported Girls on the Run and/or a girl-focused philanthropic organization through volunteer service during the biennium and describe type of service completed.
- Chapter statement (not to exceed 1,000 words) describing:
- How the alumnae chapter has supported Girls on the Run and/or a girl-focused philanthropic organization during the biennium.

Supplemental material:

- Applicants may submit no more than three pages of supplemental material (i.e. photos from philanthropic events, communication sent to members promoting volunteer and philanthropic efforts, recognition from philanthropic partners, etc.)

Hall of Fame Award

This award recognizes chapters that have shown superior efforts in all areas of an alumnae chapter, including but not limited to sisterhood, growth and retention, service/philanthropy, reporting and alumnae/collegiate relations during the biennium.

Criteria

The criteria for selection of this award include all of the following:

- Alumnae chapter was in good standing in 2024 and 2025.
- Alumnae chapter did not receive the award in the previous biennium.
- Alumnae chapter has attained the level of Order of 1874 for the prior two years on Alumnae Order of the Crescent.
- Alumnae chapter can demonstrate superiority in the areas sisterhood, growth and retention, service/philanthropy, reporting and alumnae/collegiate relations during the biennium.
- Additional consideration will be given to alumnae chapters that can demonstrate involvement at the alumnae Panhellenic level and/or promotion of the Panhellenic community.
- Certification from alumnae chapter supervisor that alumnae chapter is eligible for the award.

Award submission:

- Chapter name
- Chapter statement (not to exceed 1,500 words) describing excellence in each of these areas:
 - Sisterhood
 - Growth and retention
 - Service and philanthropy
 - Reporting
 - Collegiate/alumnae relations
 - Alumnae Panhellenic

Communication Excellence Award

This award recognizes the chapter that excels in communication.

Criteria

The criteria for selection of this award include all of the following:

- Alumnae chapter was in good standing in 2024 and 2025.
- Alumnae chapter can demonstrate superiority in alumnae chapter communications efforts during the biennium.
- Certification from alumnae chapter supervisor that alumnae chapter is eligible for the award.

Award submission:

- Chapter name
- Chapter statement (not to exceed 1,000 words) describing excellence in each of the following areas:
 - Social media
 - Website platform
 - General communications to members and alumnae

Supplemental material:

- Applicants may submit no more than three pages of supplemental material (i.e. newsletters, copies of communication to members, screenshots of chapter website, social media screenshots, etc.)

Alumnae Panhellenic Excellence Award

The award recognizes chapters that have demonstrated continuous and consistent outstanding contributions, involvement and promotion of the Panhellenic community.

Criteria:

The criteria for selection of this award include all of the following:

- Alumnae chapter was in good standing in 2024 and 2025.
- Alumnae chapter has had consistent officer representation on alumnae Panhellenic during the biennium.
- Alumnae chapter can demonstrate meaningful participation in at least 50 percent of alumnae Panhellenic activities throughout the biennium.
- Alumnae chapter can demonstrate promotion of the Panhellenic community.
- Certification from alumnae chapter supervisor that alumnae chapter is eligible for the award.

Award submission:

- Chapter name
- Name and location of alumnae Panhellenic and/or Panhellenic Area Council.
- List Panhellenic office(s) held (by rotation or election). Include name of person holding position and term of service:
- Chapter statement (not to exceed 1,000 words) describing excellence in each of the following areas:
 - Participation in alumnae Panhellenic events and initiatives
 - Ways in which the chapter or members promote Panhellenic spirit in the community
