The 2022-24 Nominating Committee (NC) met March 22-25, 2024, in Anaheim, California. After a thorough application and interview process, the 2022-24 NC confidently presents two teams of candidates to serve on International Council (IC) and the NC in the 2024-26 biennium. Per the Sorority's Bylaws, the purpose of the NC is to formulate a slate of one candidate for International President and six Vice Presidents candidates for IC, and a slate of seven candidates for the elected alumnae positions on the NC. The NC shall consist of a chairwoman, appointed by IC, seven elected alumnae members, two IC-appointed collegiate members and two IC-appointed collegiate alternates.

Marketing and Connection Strategy: Applicant Recruitment

The NC increased the collegiate applicant pool by 175% and the alumnae applicant pool by 52% from the previous biennium. The strategy included:

- 182 personal outreach emails.
- 48 one-on-one outreach calls.
- Board leadership webinars in conjunction with the Leadership Development Committee.



- Applicant mining from LinkedIn.
- In-person outreach at Gamma Phi Beta sponsored events (e.g., REAL Leadership Institute, alumnae and collegiate chapter events, Dinner With 12 Sisters, etc.).
- Multichannel social media efforts (day-in-the-life spotlights, testimonials, timeline/application details, etc.).
- Organizational email communications/newsletters.
- Infographics.
- Applicant referral form.

All job description materials were updated to highlight the specific skill sets needed to allow candidates to better see themselves in an elected leadership role.

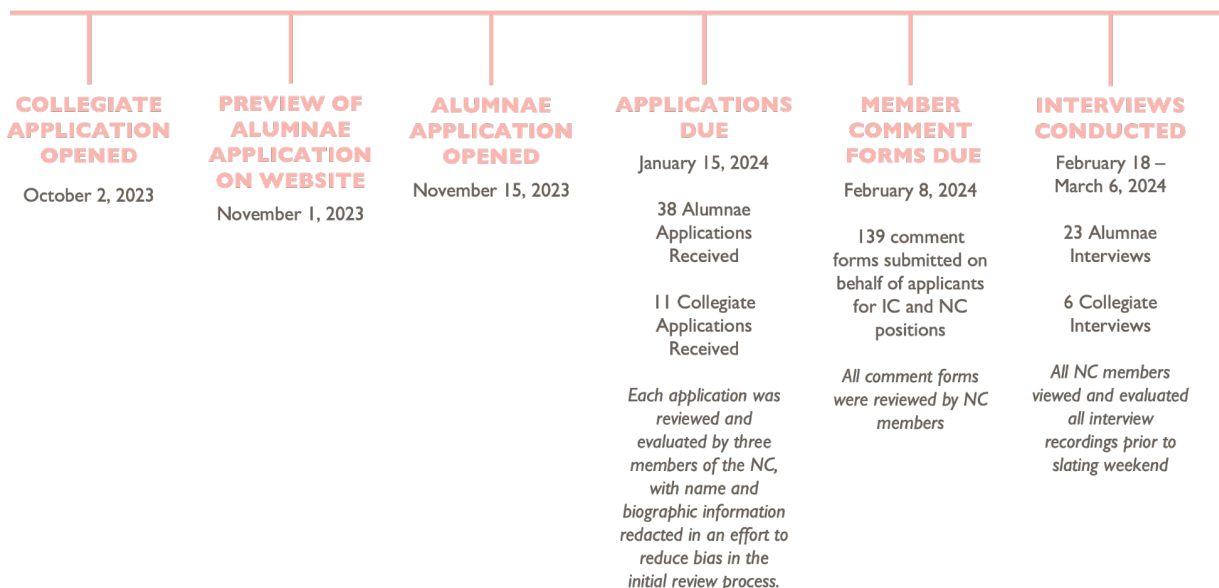
Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and Reducing Bias

For Gamma Phi Beta to continue making a positive difference in the world, the NC examined and addressed barriers to leadership for committed members who can help move our organization forward. The NC:

- Participated in implicit bias training.
- Reviewed applications redacted for identifying biographical information.
- Redesigned and restated job descriptions to increase accessibility.
- Created an equitable interview using standardized questions and process.
- Conscientiously balanced multiple considerations for a holistic evaluation of lived experiences and personal identities.

Application and Interview Process

The overall process of design, implementation and application/interview review was driven by members of the NC with technical support from staff.



Creation of Slate

The 2022-24 NC reviewed and evaluated all materials for each candidate, including application, biographic information, interview recordings and comment forms. Applicants' volunteer, lived and professional experiences were considered as well as their self-identified levels of proficiency in the Sorority's member competencies. Considering all this information, the NC formulated optimal leadership teams for both IC and the NC.

The strongest applicants for elected service have demonstrated a level of proficiency and commitment to personal growth across all our member competencies as well as an understanding of how their unique experiences and abilities could contribute to a high-functioning, representative and well-rounded team.

The priority for the NC was to slate leaders best positioned, as a team, to further the strategic priorities of the Sorority, leverage awareness of industry and cultural trends and challenges (e.g., National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) environment and evolving higher education landscape) and continue our Sorority's commitment to belonging, equity, diversity and inclusion (BEDI).
