



Frequently Asked Questions

When is the REAL Leadership Experience?

RLE will be held from July 19-22 in Norman, Oklahoma, home of Gamma Phi Beta's Psi Chapter (Oklahoma).

Who is eligible to apply for the REAL Leadership Experience?

First- or second-year members who have the desire and potential to develop lifelong leadership skills, and have not held a chapter executive council position.

When is the application deadline?

Applications with an accompanying reference are due Saturday, March 31.

Can more than one person from my chapter apply?

Yes, absolutely! However, no more than one person per chapter will be selected to attend the REAL Leadership Experience.

How much does the REAL Leadership Experience cost?

There is no fee associated with this program. All materials, meals and lodging are covered by Gamma Phi Beta thanks to the generous contributions of an alumna donor. However, selected applicants (or their chapters) must cover the cost of airfare to Will Rogers World Airport in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, or the cost of gas if choosing to drive. We strongly encourage chapters to cover these costs on behalf of selected participants.

What is included in the application process?

The application can be completed entirely online. You will be responsible for providing your demographic information and then completing several short answer questions. Additionally, you need to identify someone who can serve as a reference for you. In the application window you will send your reference a request to answer several questions about yourself. Your application is not complete until your reference has submitted their answers via the application platform.

Who should be my reference?

Your reference can be provided by your chapter president, a collegiate leadership consultant, your chapter advisor, a Gamma Phi Beta volunteer leader or alumna member, your campus fraternity/sorority advisor, another campus leader or even an employer. The best reference is someone who knows you well and can answer questions about your abilities and potential for becoming a leader in your community.



What if I don't have any leadership experience?

Then this program is for you! The REAL Leadership Experience was developed for emerging leaders to help them develop the skills and knowledge they need to become an effective leader.
